To determine categories for awards, we used the General Rules and Regulations of USA Cycling as a guide, but made some subtle changes that better reflect our event. While we encourage riders to participate in the category that best reflects their skill level, being a fund raiser, this is not enforced.

CATEGORY 1: A mountain bike category where racing skills, strength and stamina have reached an exceptional level; racing is very competitive. Riders must have a racing age of at least 15 to race as a category 1.
